Marcel Vaid (\*1967) works as a musician and composer for film and theatre. Studied guitar at the Academy of Contemporary Music in Zürich and lives in Zurich. Composition and production of filmmusic for over 80 feature films. Head of the electro-acoustic experimental collective «Superterz», numerous Tours in Japan and Europe. Member of the European Filmacademy EFA and the Swiss Filmacademy. President Smecca - Swiss Media Composers Association.

Collaborations a.o. with Nils Petter Molvaer, Kate Havnevik, Norbert Möslang (Voice Crack), Marianne Schroeder (John Cage), Koychi Makigami (Hikazu), Toshinori Kondo, Mauro Pawlowski (dEUS), Jojo Mayer or Alain Monot (The Young Gods). In film Marcel Vaid has worked a.o. with Fredi Murer, Erika Kubarska, Marcus Vetter, Milo Rau, Léa Pool, Greg Zglinski, Tommaso Landucci, David Pinillos or oscar-nominated Timo von Gunten.

Marcel Vaid's most important goal is to develop an individual language, an individual and discreet soundscape for every film. In the foreground is the motto LESS IS MORE. An outstanding sound-aesthetical concern is the examination of acoustical instruments and their stereoscopic processing in the computer. Marcel Vaid's film music has also been recorded by big symphony orchestras such as the 21st Century Orchestra Lucerne (with conductor Ludwig Wicky) or the Budapest Art Orchestra, conducted by André Belmont. Marcel Vaid gives diverse Masterclasses and is working as a guest lecturer at the Zurich University of the Arts.

Marcel Vaid has been honoured a number of times. He has just been nominated for the 7<sup>th</sup> time for the Swiss Filmprize Quartz 'Best Filmmusic' 2021 for «Not Me - A journey with Not Vital». To this day he received four times the Swiss Film Prize ('Zara' 2009, 'Goodnight Nobody' 2011, 'When the sun fell' 2016 and 'Chris the Swiss' 2019), the Prix Fondation Suisa ('Tandoori Love' 2009), the prize for Best Film Score at the Filmfestivals in Angers ('Joshua' 2003, Jurypresident Jeanne Moreau) and Valencia ('Where is Max' 2009). In 2012 he received the 'Zurich City Award' (Werkjahr der Stadt Zürich).

His composition in 'Chris the Swiss' was nominated 2019 for the German Filmmusicprize, 2018 for 'Best Music' at the 'European Animation Award' in Lille, and for the Cristal-Pine-Award 'Best Music' at the ISFMF in Pula, Croatia.

Nomination Swiss Filmprize Quartz 'Best Filmmusic' in 2019 for «The Kongo Tribunal» 2016 for «Köpek» (Double nomination). 2009 Nomination 'Best Filmmusic' at the Filmfestival Aubagne for «Goodnight Nobody».
